Mennonites and homes have a long history ... home clean up, home repair, home building. Often after a flood, a hurricane, a war, and usually "over there", where someone else's "Inn" has been damaged. MCC Ontario recently helped birth a new organization, MennoHomes Inc. into that rich history of homes. And that history is ready for another chapter, one that is unfolding here in Waterloo Region, our community, in our "Inn".

Many of our neighbours have been met with a "No" when they seek room at the inn. Many others have spoken clearly that they want a just response to inadequate housing. They want our community to be a welcoming inn, one that can say "Yes, there is room at the Inn."

MennoHomes Inc. hopes to be a vehicle that allows us to expand affordable rental housing capacity so more of us find room at the Inn.

ACTION!

MennoHomes Inc. is in the process of purchasing land (225' x 200') from Faith Lutheran Church on Village Road near Westmount in Kitchener. Close to churches, schools, medical services and public transportation, it is in an excellent location. As soon as the land is severed, and a title obtained, the purchase will be completed. We hope to start construction no later than spring for up to 24 family units.

SUPPORT

Late last year MennoHomes began a fundraising campaign to raise \$360,000. To date supporters have provided \$300,000 in cash and pledges! The campaign will continue until the goal is met. MennoHomes Inc. is grateful to God and to you for your support and affirmation.
