New Affordable Housing Project in Kitchener

MennoHomes' new affordable housing project at 544 Bridgeport Road East in Kitchener is underway. Demolition has been completed and construction is on track to begin by the end of May. This new project is the result of a unique partnership with St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church and Parents for Community Living.

Phase 1 of this redevelopment will create 48 new residential homes with a mix of one and two-bedroom units. The waiting list for affordable housing in Waterloo Region has grown to almost 5,000 households in the past year. The \$5 million A Place to Call Home capital campaign was launched in January to raise the funds necessary to complete this project.




MennoHomes held its Annual General Meeting on January 31st at 50 Kent Ave. Kitchener. It was a packed house with 85 people in attendance. The


